For the future of football in this country, thus we need solid collaboration and cooperation among all relevant agencies, stakeholders and football clubs to achieve our desired goals. Furthermore, as with other sports and in the context of this forum,

our young talents in football must be nurtured continuously and adequately through strategic programmes and projects to develop them further to become more skillful, creative and strategic in gameplay. Therefore, it is time to consider reinventing Interschool Football Tournaments and the National Youth Football Championship. Something that we all can ponder and work it out together.

Furthermore, initiatives to hold national leagues for young players such as the DST League must also be continued to nurture the skills of younger generations so they can progress to the next level in further developing football in this country.

Lastly, on behalf of the Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports, I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt gratitude and thanks for everyone involved in organizing this Football Forum. I strongly believe that the time, resources and effort that we spend at this Football Forum will generate multifold benefits, not just for football but in further advancing the development of sports in Brunei as a whole.
