



## PETIKAN TITAH



Bagi mencapai Wawasan Brunei 2035 yang semakin mendekat, para belia turut memainkan peranan penting sebagai Pemacu Transformasi Ekonomi. Beta gembira melihat terdapatnya perubahan 'mindset' di kalangan belia dimana belia sekarang sudah berani beralih dari pencari kerja kepada pencipta peluang pekerjaan, dengan meneroka bidang keusahawanan dan perniagaan.

Dalam **Bidang Keusahawanan**, Beta sedia menyedari bahawa antara cabaran utama yang dihadapi ialah kesukaran mendapatkan pinjaman kewangan (access to funding) bagi memulakan perniagaan. Situasi ini lebih dirasakan oleh golongan belia yang tidak mempunyai rekod prestasi perniagaan dan sumber cagaran (collateral).

Maka kearah ini, Beta sukacita memaklumkan bahawa satu skim pembiayaan mikro patuh-syarak telah diwujudkan, khusus bagi usahawan belia, hasil kolaborasi strategik di antara Kementerian Kebudayaan Belia dan Sukan dan Bank Usahawan Berhad. Skim ini dinamakan '**BizBelia**' dan memberikan peluang kepada pengusaha-pengusaha belia tempatan untuk mendapatkan sumber kewangan daripada institusi kewangan tempatan. Inisiatif ini diharapkan akan dapat merangsang pertumbuhan dan perkembangan perusahaan belia tempatan dan menjadi teladan kepada institusi-institusi kewangan lain ke arah memudah cara penglibatan lebih ramai para usahawan belia.

Beta menaruh harapan yang tinggi bagi inisiatif ini dapat dimanfaatkan sepenuhnya oleh golongan belia di negara ini dalam sama-sama meningkatkan pertumbuhan ekonomi negara. Beta turut menaruh keyakinan dengan adanya bimbingan serta dokongan yang padu dari pihak-pihak yang berkenaan, para usahawan belia kita akan mampu menyerlah bukan saja di peringkat kebangsaan malah peringkat antarabangsa.

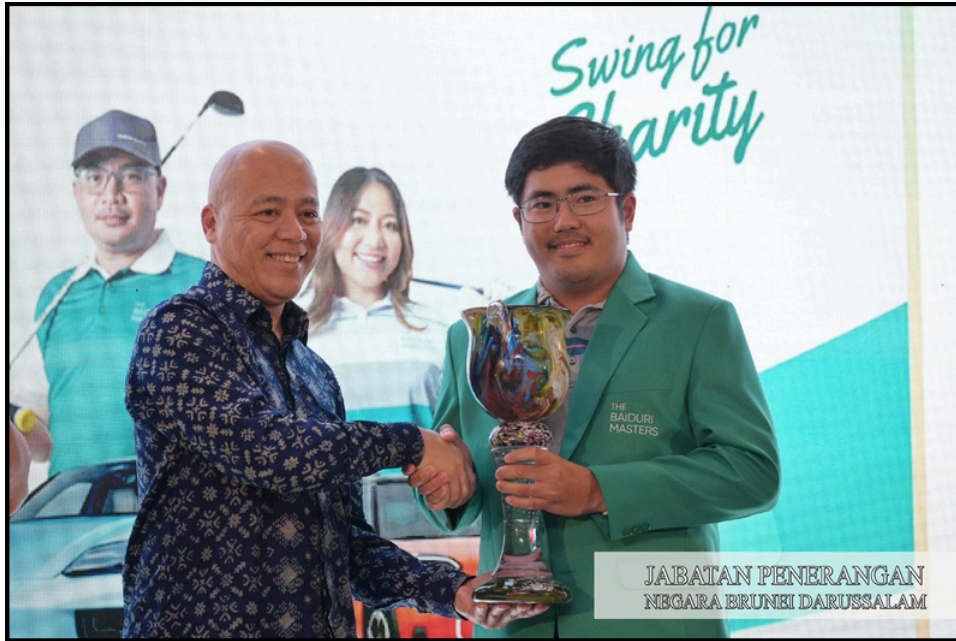

## THE BORNEO 2025 OPEN MEN'S DOUBLES DART CHAMPIONSHIP



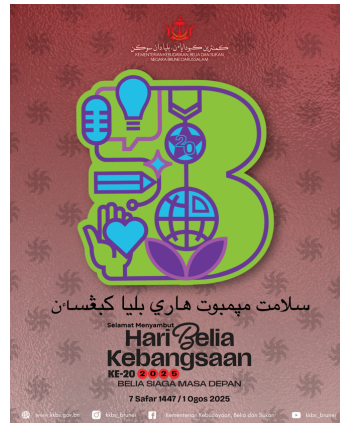
