



PETIKAN TITAH



Rakyat Beta yang beragama Islam yang Beta kasihi, marilah kita bersama-sama mengalu-alukan kehadiran Ramadhan. Ramadhan adalah penghulu segala bulan. Darjatnya sangat tinggi di sisi Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala. Di dalamnya Al-Qur'an diturunkan.

Terdapat riwayat menyebut, bahawa semua pintu langit dan pintu syurga dibuka pada bulan Ramadhan, manakala pintu-pintu neraka pula ditutup dan semua iblis serta syaitan dirantai, supaya mereka tidak dapat mengacau kita Umat Islam yang sedang berpuasa.

Riwayat lain juga menyebut bahawa siapa yang menghampiri diri kepada Allah Subhanahu Wata'ala, dengan satu sembahyang dalam bulan Ramadhan, adalah sama imbangannya dengan tujuh puluh (70) sembahyang pada lain-lain bulan. Dan satu sembahyang sunat, sama imbangannya dengan satu sembahyang fardhu.

Demikian, hebatnya kelebihan Ramadhan. Oleh itu, Beta berharap, kita umat Islam, janganlah mengabaikan kelebihan ini dan memanfaatkan peluang yang cuma didapat, sekali sahaja dalam setahun dengan melakukan ibadat-ibadat seperti bertadarus Al-Qur'an, Sembahyang Tarawih, Qiamullail, sedekah dan lain-lain.

"Puasa itu adalah pendinding. Maka manakala seorang kamu berpuasa, hendaklah dia tidak bercakap kotor, tidak berlaku jahat (fasik), dan tidak berpura-pura jahil terhadap hukum. Jika orang mencercanya atau mengajaknya berkelahi, maka hendaklah ia berkata: "Sesungguhnya aku sedang berpuasa".

Selain dari bercakap kotor dan berkelahi boleh merosakkan puasa, Beta melihat yang turut mustahak juga dijaga ialah hal ehwal permakanan. Menjaga permakanan ini sangatlah penting supaya ia bersih dan halal, bukan tercemar oleh unsur haram atau syubhah. Ugama Islam juga sangat mementingkan kesihatan dan di antara langkah paling berkesan untuk mengekalkan kesihatan ialah melalui permakanan. Walaupun permakanan dalam bulan puasa sering didapati pelbagai atau beraneka, kita selaku umat Islam perlu mengelak pembaziran dan makan minum yang berlebih-lebihan dengan mengikuti kaedah yang dituntut dalam hadis Nabi Muhammad Sallallahu 'Alaihi Wasallam iaitu sukatan: sepertiga untuk makanan, sepertiga lagi untuk minuman dan sepertiga pula untuk bernafas. Jika badan sihat, semua aktiviti peribadatan dapat dilaksanakan dengan sempurna dan kita dapat sama-sama meraih kelebihan pada bulan yang penuh keberkatan ini.

**MESSAGE BY THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, YOUTH AND SPORTS IN
CONJUNCTION WITH INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY 2025**



Saturday, 7 Ramadan 1446 / 8 March 2025 - Brunei Darussalam once again celebrates **International Women's Day** on **8 March**, an opportunity to honour the contributions and celebrate the achievements of all women and girls.

This year's theme, "**For ALL Women and Girls: Rights. Equity. Empowerment**", highlights the importance of guaranteeing rights, equal opportunities, and support for them to achieve their full potential. Such support must also come from within **families** to ensure that family roles are balanced, and all women are given opportunities, the space to thrive and a conducive environment so they can contribute actively to nation building.

Brunei Darussalam remains committed to ensuring the **protection and well-being of women and girls** through various initiatives to safeguard their safety, rights, and welfare, including through laws and policies to protect women from domestic violence and abuse, while providing support to their active involvement in education, employment and leadership.

Alhamdulillah, findings from the **Research on Women's Development in Brunei Darussalam** have identified several **notable achievements** in the participation and accomplishments of Bruneian women, particularly in the fields of education and employment:

- a. In **education**, female participation at **primary and secondary levels** is close to **100%**, reflecting the success of compulsory education and universal access to education. Women also make up the **majority of tertiary graduates**, particularly in education, health, and business, with growing participation in technical and ICT fields.
- b. In **employment**, women’s participation in the labour force remains **strong**, with **76% of women aged 25 to 54** actively contributing to the national economy. Brunei Darussalam also ranks among the leading ASEAN countries, with **37% of managerial positions** held by women. In the public sector, women account for **56% of the workforce**, including **65% in senior management roles**.

This year also marks the 30th Anniversary of the **Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action (BPFA)** which aims to advance women’s participation and leadership across all sectors. Brunei Darussalam’s recent BPFA progress report highlighted the following achievements:

- a. Women in Brunei Darussalam continue to **excel in leadership and decision-making roles**. In 2022, **almost half** of Permanent Secretaries and Deputy Permanent Secretaries **were women**. Women also hold positions as Ministers, Deputy Ministers, Ambassadors, Heads of Mission, the Attorney General, High Court Judges, and Chief Executive Officers in both the public and private sectors.
- b. Women also play an **active role in entrepreneurship**, supported by government and private sector initiatives, particularly in digital and financial training. Recent data from the **Ministry of Finance and Economy** shows that, as of February 2025, a total of **7,630 women** are registered under the Registry of Companies and Business Names, while **15,878 business entities** are owned by women.

While these achievements are commendable, continuous support from all sectors remains essential to further empower women and girls. Among the ongoing initiatives are:




- a. The **IDEAS Project (Enhancing Digital Economy Participation for ASEAN Women MSMEs)**, an ASEAN programme funded by the ASEAN-Korea Cooperation Fund (AKCF) to support women entrepreneurs across ASEAN countries. In Brunei Darussalam, the project, to be run through DARE in collaboration with an NGO, will train **242 women entrepreneurs** across **15 cohorts** from June 2024 to December 2025, with training in e-commerce, digital marketing, and business model development.
- b. The **Academy for Women Entrepreneurs (AWE)** programme, supported by U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, also continues to support local women entrepreneurs through business training, mentoring, and networking opportunities. Since its launch in 2021, in Brunei Darussalam, through DARE, a total of **66 women entrepreneurs** have completed the programme.
- c. Before entering the world of work, the **"Bersedialah Wanita" (PREPanita) Programme**, organised by the Department of Community Development (JAPEM), has been conducted consistently for four consecutive years since 2021 for tertiary students from public and private higher education institutions. This programme raises awareness on women's rights, and prepares women, as well as men to face challenges with resilience, and introduces the concept of Work-Life Harmony.

Brunei Darussalam remains committed to strengthening the rights, equity, and empowerment of women and girls through national initiatives, international frameworks, and strategic partnerships. When women and girls are empowered, it will lead to stronger families, harmonious communities, and a more prosperous nation.

In closing, I wish **all women in Brunei Darussalam a Happy International Women's Day**. May you continue to succeed and contribute to the nation's unity and development for the benefit of our Monarch, Nation, People, and Religion.
