WALKATON RATAP SOLIDARITY FOR THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE



BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, Monday, 19 Jamadilakhir 1445 / 1 January 2024 - The RATAP Walkathon (Palestinian Tabung Amal Riadah) saw participation from more than 300 individuals. The event was organized by the WARGAMAS Organization in collaboration with several entities, including the Ministry of Culture, Youth, and Sports (MCYS), the Ministry for Ugama Affairs (MORA), the Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Foundation, the TAIB Association, the University of Brunei Darussalam (UBD), the Authority for Information and Communications Technology of Brunei Darussalam (AITI), and the Brunei Darussalam Volunteers.

Yang Mulia Pengiran Mohammad Amirrizal bin Pengiran Haji Mahmud, Permanent Secretary (Sports) of the Ministry of Culture, Youth, and Sports was present as the guest of honor and officiated the walkathon.

The event commenced with a speech by Head of Pertubuhan WARGAMAS and Chairman of RATAP, Yang Mulia Awang Haji Abu Bakar bin Haji Mohd. Don. This was followed by a donation to RATAP by the guest of honor.


- 1. Sultan Sharif Ali Islamic University (UNISSA), submitted a contribution amounting to Thirteen Thousand (BND13,000.00);



HANDOVER CEREMONY OF GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO DISASTER VICTIMS





BERAKAS, Tuesday, 18 Rejab 1445 / 30 January 2024 - Fifteen heads of family involved in the floods, fires, strong winds, and ruined or dilipidated houses have received financial assistance from the Government of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Negara Brunei Darussalam through the Department of Community Development, the Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports. The event took place in the building of the Ministry of Culture, Youth and Sports.

A total of nine (9) heads of family out of fifteen (15) who received financial assistance today were victims of the flood incident; one (1) heads of family affected by the fire incident, two (2) heads of family affected by a house collapse or dilipidation, and three (3) heads of family affected by the storm incident. All the victims and residents involved in the disaster are safe and uninjured.

The provision of this financial assistance is intended to alleviate the hardships experienced by the victims of disasters for the well-being of their families. This effort demonstrates the concern of the government for the people and the population affected by the disaster.
